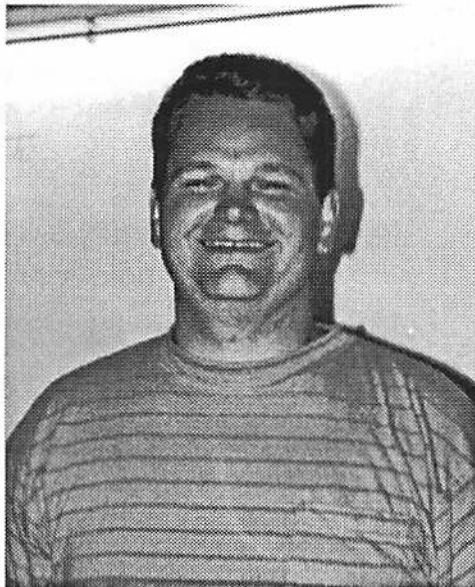
FrameMaker

FrameMaker, an award winning page design program, makes its return to SMUG's meetings after a disappointing failure of the room's equipment earlier in the spring. Travis Huch, Frame Corporate Account Manager, good humoredly accepted the potential for disappointment and graciously agreed to return with this favorite program for creating long, technical documents.

Frame has a wide range of capabilities: graphics, equation editing, page layout, flexible table editor, merging of columns, and even rotating of columns. System 7 compatible, FrameMaker 3.0 has become a popular choice of professional writers.

Lotus 1,2,3

Lotus 1,2,3, gets four mice from MacUser in comments about its "depth and accessibility and interface" as a spreadsheet program for the Mac. It certainly has quickly gained a respected position as contender for leadership in the spreadsheet field. Virtually every interface element can be opened, closed, moved in the working environment. With 1,2,3 you can use the Copy and Paste Special commands to convert cell formulas to values. Even though this program is powerful, the average user will find it no trouble to use and access.

voice commands." You can just use their "Voice User Interface" and the Mac carries out what is to happen. It can be used with any Mac application and can allow you to save time bypassing the mouse.

They claim you can improve your productivity at least 50% because you can type and talk at the same time, formatting, changing style and fonts, just by saying them. For those who don't have sound compatible Macs, Articulate Systems can provide hardware that

expands your ability to use Voice Navigator.

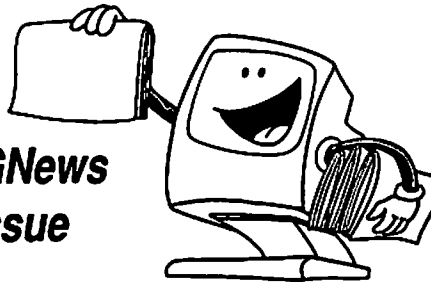

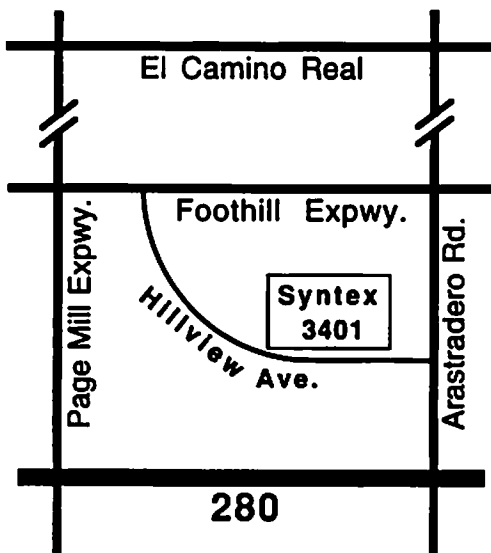

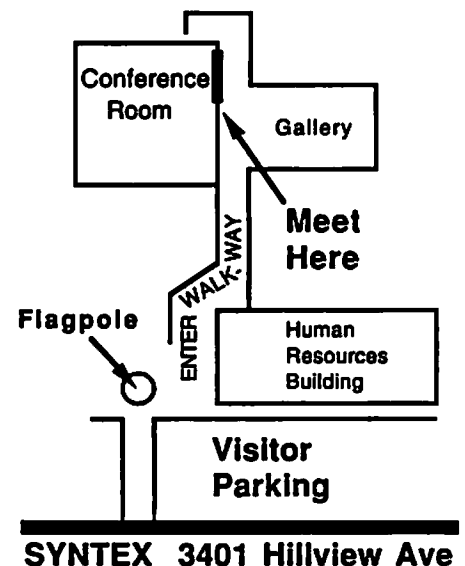
